Michael J. Foycik, Jr. is an experienced patent attorney, practicing patent and trademark law since 1982. He has appeared before the CAFC on appeal for patent and trade secret litigation, and has been involved in numerous court cases for clients involving patents, trademarks, and copyrights.

Mr. Foycik currently represents clients with groundbreaking innovations in the fields of exosomes, CBD medical formulations, advanced high capacity batteries, ultra-miniature sensors and communication devices, medical technologies, sterilizing and sanitizing devices for medical devices, as well as biomedical and dental devices.
